
Sub: inclusion of ophthalmic procedures (paediatrics and neonates) under Swasthya Sathi

This was under active consideration to include some **ophthalmic procedures for Paediatrics and neonates** under Swasthya Sathi for prevention of blindness. As per the recommendation of the expert committee following procedures for paediatrics and neonates are added in the package list under under Swasthya Sathi :

Sl. No	Package Id	Procedures	Name of the Package	Package Cost (Rs.)	Remarks
1	SS14000048	Ophthalmology	Paediatrics/Neonates cataract surgery with Intraocular lens implantation	18,000	Paediatric cataract surgery is a specialized surgery which can only be performed by specially trained surgeons This surgery requires special set of instruments which includes special vitrectomy machine. It is desirable that a foldable intraocular lens is implanted in the child's eye after removal of the cataract so that it is well adapted within the child's eye and has a lifelong durability.
2	SS14000049	Ophthalmology	Intravitreal injection of anti-vascular endothelial growth factor for Paediatrics/ Neonates	8,000	Drug cost may be allowed additionally as per actual requirement following Swasthya Sathi Scheme guidelines
3	SS14000050	Ophthalmology	Laser photocoagulation for retinopathy of prematurity (ROP) for Paediatrics/Neonates	13,000 (per sitting per eye)	Laser in ROP is a vision salvaging procedure and is of paramount importance Usually required for premature children in both eyes

The above procedures for Paediatrics/neonates should be available in Superspeciality ophthalmology set-up of NABH accredited hospitals having previous experience of conducting the above mentioned procedures.
